Human Chain

Grades: 4-6

Number of Players: As many as you want!

Where to Play: Outside or in an open area

How to Play:

- Two players are 'it'.
- The two players hold hands and chase people.
- When they tag another player, that player joins the chain by linking hands.
- When another player is caught they can stay together or split 2 and 2
- They must split in even numbers and can link together with other groups if they want
- The game is played until nobody is left. The last two players are "it" for the next round.

Safety Tips: Students are not to push other students and not to pull on each others arms while connected in a chain.
